Start!!

You are now ready to start offering and delivering Cutting Edge at your club – work through the awards with the young skiers and riders at your club from Bronze to Gold

Awards and Prizes

There are prizes available for the young skiers and riders who achieve their silver and gold awards. Once you have coached your young skiers and rider through an award, make sure you do the following to ensure they receive the rewards they deserve;

BRONZE

- ✓ Sign the certificate
- ✓ Present it to the skier/rider

SILVER

- ✓ Sign off each stage of their booklet
- ✓ Submit the skier/rider's information online
- ✓ Receive a 'Silver Cutting Edge wristband' from BWSW
- ✓ Present wristband to the Silver skier/rider

GOLD

- ✓ Sign off each stage of the booklet
- ✓ Submit the skier/rider's information online
- ✓ BWSW will send out a 'Gold Cutting Edge Goodie Bag' directly to the skier/rider



Now make sure you are able to offer a 'pathway' for your gold award winners to continue participating at the club – you could;

- ✓ Offer a discounted membership for the rest of the season
- ✓ Signpost them to sessions with coaching that would be suitable
- ✓ Encourage them to enter club or local competitions

Once your Cutting Edge programme is set up at your club, you may want to think about the following;

- → Entering your young skiers & riders into the annual Cutting Edge Competition
- → Running a 'Club Cutting Edge Competition'
