Short lines

Short column	(x1 pic)	125 words
Single column	(x1 pic)	200 words
Qtr page	(x1 pic)	200-250 words

Events Scoop

Short column	(x2 pics)	125 words
Single column	(x2 pics)	200 words
Qtr page	(x2 pics)	200-250 words

Feature pages

Single page	600 - 750 words
Double page spread	1200 - 1500 words

What format should I use?

It is helpful to us if you would supply your copy in a single Microsoft Word file with clear indicators for the main and subheadings.

If you do not have Word you can send your text in the body of your email. If possible use Microsoft Outlook Express.

How should I send my image files?

You can send your jpeg image files via email as an attachment, please clearly name each image. It is generally a good idea to name each file with the heading title from your article followed by 123 depending on how many images you are sending.

JPG Example: Wakeboard/image1.jpg
Wakeboard/image2.jpg
Wakeboard/image3.jpg

Please Note: Do not embed images into word files or the body of an email

Acceptable file formats

JPG - EPS - TIF - PDF are all acceptable file formats. Each file should be saved as CMYK with a minimum resolution of 300dpi. When saving and compressing a JPG file, please use the highest setting possible.
