Entry & Costs

The closing date for Entries is Monday 15th July 2024 £50 For all entries

Online Payment and Entries close at 5pm on Monday 15th July. Anyone wanting to enter Nationals after this date will be charged a late entry fee.

The charge for Late Entry is £10 per day after Monday 15th July. So, if you enter on Tuesday 16th July your entry would be £60

Late Entries will be accepted up to Wednesday 24th July but only at the higher entry fee. If you wait until 24th July to enter, the entry fee will be £140. (£50 Entry, £90 Late Fee)

Late Entries can only be made by phoning the BWSW Office on 01932 560007 – Payment must be made at the time of the call.

You must be a fully paid-up member of BWSW to be able to enter and pay for the National Championships. If your membership has lapsed, you will be able to enter the competition by calling the BWSW office on the above number. You will have to pay your BWSW Membership at the same time you pay for your competition entry fee. It is not possible to enter the competition without your membership.

No exceptions to the late entry fee will be made to competitors that have not been able to enter due to not being members of BWSW.

IT WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE TO ENTER THE COMPETITION AFTER 5pm ON WEDNESDAY 24th JULY

ALL ENTRANTS MUST ALSO ENTER THE COMPETITION ON Cablewakeboard.net by 26th July to allow the start lists and more detailed timetables to be created.

Cablewakeboard.net is not connected to BWSW and joining here does not mean you have entered the competition. We require you to join here to allow the competition scoring software to work. If you do







not enter here, we will not be able to include you in any of the start lists.

To enter on cablewakeboard.net – log into your account (or create one if you are new), once you are in, click on the 'my competitions' tab. Find the UK Cable Wakeboard Nationals and 'Join' the competition, select the category you will be entering, and then answer the question. If you are entering Wakeboard and Wakeskate you will need to join both competitons.

Registration

Passports must be shown on registration, as Nationalities and Ages must be checked.

These are required as part of the IWWF Doping requirements and all athletes (competitors) must produce their passport for checking at Registration.

REGISTRATION WILL TAKE PLACE BETWEEN:

Friday 26th July – 6pm until 8pm. Saturday 27th July – 9am – 11am

You will not be allowed to start official practice until your Registration is complete and you have your official riders bib.

All riders must wear their official bib for Official Practice.

The UK National Championships is only open for UK Nationals to enter. You must be in possession of either a UK Passport or Birth Certificate. You are eligible to compete if you(or your parents) were born in England/Wales/Scotland/Northern Ireland/British Overseas Territory (parents serving in Armed Forces or working in Embassies) or are deemed as a UK National resident in possession of a passport of Great Britain and Northern Ireland. For riders with dual nationality, you will be eligible to ride in the UK Nationals if you have not competed for your other nationality.

Accommodation

Spring Lakes are offering a 30% discount for Onsite Wild Camping and Electric Hook Up pitches for Friends and Families during Nationals.

Special Deal for Riders wanting to Practice Before Nationals

Spring Lakes are offering the following to anyone who has paid for their entry to the National Championships – Please bring proof of entry with you.

Event Day Pass at the same price as a normal 2hr session for up to 4 Visits between 27th May – 26th July.

The 2hr Pass is £35.00. You need to book this pass online, or on arrival if there is availability and make staff aware on check in that you are intending to ride all-day, they will check you off against the list of Entered riders for Nationals and check off number of times you have been.

The Park

Springlakes Watersports & Leisure was founded in 2019 & based in the Midlands between Derby & Nottingham just off the M1.

Our site covers some 300 ares of water over 4 lakes with 150 acres of woods & parkland bordering the Attenbrough Nature reserve and river Trent.

Our wake park - Wake Springlakes features a full Rixen 5 tower system with the cable running height of 12 meters.

The cable park has all Unit high quality plastic moulded features & a cube wave break.

We also have a Rixen Master beginners straight line cable * Rixen Master Silver progression straight line cable on site.

The wake park building features a full 2 storey structure containing a café / licenced bar / recreational seating area / equipment & apparel shop & a judging viewing balcony.

We also offer camping in all forms from wild camping to fully serviced hard standing pitches.

We also run an Aquapark, Stand Up Paddleboarding, Open Water Swimming, Kayaks, Scuba diving a beach & have a huge marquee that serves as a function area for events and could be used for the presentations if the weather is bad. Wake Springlakes has been hosting training weekend for Team GB cable Team for the past two seasons and have received great reviews of the park.
