Development and Training Days 2025

Development Days

Successful Development Days have taken place at Town Loch, Cotswolds and Dams Watersports. Thanks to Tom Parkin, Glen Campbell and Damien Ackerer for coaching.

Invitational 'Talent Spot' Trick/Slalom Days

We have decided to refine the offering this year and propose to run an invitational 'talent spot' day at Rickmansworth and possibly at an additional site this year. This initiative will focus on strong, young skiers who may have the potential to ski for Britain in the future. More details to come.

Invitational Jump Camp

We shall also offer an invitational jump event to create a cohort of young competitive skiers in the jump event. This will focus primarily on those skiers we have already taught to jump from prior Development Days, and we hope will create a strong bond between those skiers too. More details to come.

Youngsters' Intro' Days

We are also proposing one or two intro days for young skiers feeding into clubs. Again, more details to follow as plans are finalised.

Under-21 Slalom/SBD3/Coaching/Judging Camp

Finally, we have agreed that we should run a day, for promising under-21(non-team) skiers who have much to offer as both skiers and officials in the future. The idea would be to enhance their skiing and competition preparation whilst also preparing them for SBD3 Driver qualifications alongside coaching and judging qualifications. This might be a one or two day affair and is work in progress.
