The 106th 200 Club, October 2025 prize draw has taken place With 166 numbers this month and a prize pot of £1,348.75 the lucky winners are:



After a huge success last year WWS are looking to expand this for the 2026 season by piloting it at 3 more Scottish Sites (Aboyne, Kyle and Glasgow), as well as introducing more days over the summer holidays at Town Loch.

To support this project, they require more equipment such as a new boom, inflatable ski, and smaller combo skis. The aim is to keep participation costs as low as possible for the sessions as to remove any financial barriers.

Projected Spend 2025

FoT Basic

The projected spend for 2025 is now £48,644. With this spend we are now forecasting a carryover amount into 2026 of around £23,600. This is reduced from earlier estimates primarily due to fewer Development Days and training camps than originally planned. It does mean however that we can sustain a similar spend in 2026.
